No	Question	Answer
1	Are you planning to provide an aggregation tool to efficiently aggregate the self-diagnosis results of our suppliers?	Yes, we will provide a tool for aggregation.
2	It would be easier to create our internal system if the numbers of required items were consistent with either JIS or JAMP.
